The apprenticeship

The Level 3 Digital Marketer course focuses on developing skills and competencies which will be directly applied at Seriun. The course will teach you a range of technical abilities, marketing specific knowledge and understanding, and fundamental skills, attitudes, and behaviours.

Course Entry criteria: Level 2 English and maths

End Point Assessment: Once you have completed the course, you will undertake an End Point Assessment, which consists of 4 elements:

- Summative Portfolio: Present evidence from real-work projects, illustrating the application of all the knowledge, skills and behaviours set out in the programme.
- Synoptic Project: A pre-defined, business-related project designed to test the learner against a selection of the knowledge, skills and behaviours.
- Employer Reference: The employer's perspective on performance and how they have applied their knowledge, competencies and behaviours in work projects.
- Interview: A structured discussion between the learner and independent assessor, focusing on the portfolio, synoptic project and employer reference. This will provide an opportunity for further evidence to be gathered and/or evidence to be explored in more detail.
